

Overview:

Bayside Church is organising a cross-cultural missions trip to Bali.

Dates:

24 September – 6 October.

These dates have been chosen to help families who may like to do a missions trip during the school holidays. If there is not sufficient interest from families, these dates may be subject to change.

This trip is suitable for singles, couples and families with primary and above aged children. This application form needs to be filled out for every member on the trip (including children)>

Cost:

Approximately \$2400 which will cover flights, accommodation, transport, insurance, meals, as well as ministry expenses such as building supplies, prison packs, hospitality, gifts for children. Spending money is extra.

Availability:

Spaces are limited and the attached application will need to be completed.

What the mission's trip involves:

- Four to five days working in a rural Balinese community
 - Building a water tank for families in rural Balinese communities
 - Teaching English and computer skills to primary aged children
 - Helping with a Cattle Project including feeding and cleaning
- C3 Church Bali – helping with any practical/handy work of the D House and building relationships with D House residents
- Leadership Skills – teaching and running practical workshops
- Compassion – running games and children's programs
- Prison Ministry – this may include running hygiene workshops, attending a chapel service or simply visiting prisoners (please note this is not guaranteed until closer to the time)

This trip is not a holiday but you will have the opportunity to explore parts of Bali during free time.

The process:

If you would like to be considered for this trip you will need to do the following:

- Completed the following application form and return to Bayside Church by **Friday 28 April**.
- Successful applicants will be advised by Friday 19 May
- A deposit of \$1000 is required by 16 June to secure your place.
- Balance of \$1400 will be required by 1 August.
