THE LETTER TO THE EPHESIANS (4)

INFORMATION + REVELATION = TRANSFORMATION

Message Notes

The information and revelation the apostle has given in the first three chapters is now applied in transformation in the last three...

In chapter 4 we see how this revelation transforms our:

Unity (1-6)
Diversity (7-16)
Purity (17-32).

Text: Ephesians 4:1-6

<u>1. Unity (1-6)</u>

We already have unity but we must work hard at keeping it. Why? Because we are all so different: tastes & habits, intellect & feeling, differences in opinion, education & temperament, race, gender & culture, economic & family background etc.

Look around; we are all so different (if it wasn't for Jesus most of us wouldn't even know each other). But here we are together in one comm<u>unity</u> so we have to <u>make every effort</u> to keep unity! When we don't <u>make every effort</u> disaster is the result!

"Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace..."

Ephesians 4:4-6 lists 7 things we should focus on in order to maintain unity in the church community:

<u>One body</u> – One church in the world

One Spirit – The Holy Spirit who indwells every believer.

<u>One hope</u> – The hope that comes from our common salvation

One Lord – Jesus the Saviour of the world

<u>One faith</u> – If we share the same faith in the same Lord why shouldn't we be in unity?

<u>One baptism</u> –the baptism by the Holy Spirit into the Body of Christ

One God – not many gods but ONE God who we all love (which leads to unity)

Jesus prayed: "That all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us **so that the world may believe that you have sent me**" (John 17:21)

Qualities needed to keep unity:

Peace: Unity first comes from the inside rather than externals

<u>Humility</u>: Don't promote yourself, be interested in others! Phil 2:3, "*…in humility consider others better than yourselves*"

<u>Gentleness</u>: to endure offences without anger or a desire of revenge, but rather to exercise a forgiving spirit.

<u>Patience</u>: putting up with the shortcomings, faults, and weaknesses of others – in love (1 Corinthians 13:2-4)

2. Diversity (7-16)

3. Purity (17-32)

God's lavish grace and His love that surpasses knowledge are never an excuse to live a sloppy life. A cheap grace that says, "I can live like I want to live because God will just forgive me" was never the intention of the Gospel (Romans 6:1-2)
